All entry fee checks or money orders (US funds) are to be made payable to CAPER. One check is sufficient for all enclosed entries.

Entries must be received by **6 pm CDT Friday April 2**, after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is acceptable) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will render the entry invalid; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via cash, certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature.

**Entries received without signature release will be refused.**

**Refunds:** Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Show Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show/trial. There will be no refunds for bitches in season in obedience or rally.

**Fax/email entries:** Entries may be faxed to the Show/Trial Secretary at 206-222-2830, or emailed to secretary@caper-dogs.com. Both the front and back of each entry form must be included, completely filled out and signed, or the entry will not be accepted. A copy of the entry fee check must also be faxed/emailed at the same time as the entries. Entry forms with fees must be mailed with a postmark no later than April 2, and received no later than April 6, or the entry will not be accepted. **Entry fees must include a \$2.00 charge per entry form submitted. Payment by credit card will not be accepted.**

**Entry Acknowledgements:** To ensure the receipt of your entries, it is suggested that you include a valid email address which you regularly check on your entry form, as that will allow the Secretary to send an email receipt of entry. If you do not have email, send a self-addressed, stamped postcard or envelope with your entry, which the Trial Secretary will return upon entry receipt. Judging programs and entry confirmations will be mailed to each exhibitor as soon as possible after the closing date. If the confirmation is to be sent to a person other than the dog's owner, please include with the entry the name and address or email address to which it is to be sent. Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of entries. Any errors will be corrected prior to closing; exhibitor errors discovered after closing cannot be corrected. Duplicate entries will not be refunded after closing. Overpayments of less than \$10 will not be refunded.

**Moveups to Best of Breed or Open Jr Show classes:** Dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for this show may be transferred from the Dog or Bitch class to the Best of Breed class. Similarly, an entrant in a Novice Junior Showmanship can be transferred to Open if the junior has earned a third 1st place after this show's closing date. Each of these transfer requests must be made to, and accepted by, the Show Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at this show.

### Non-Regular Classes (multiple dog entries)

Winners of these classes are not eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

#### Stud Dogs Brood Bitches

Dogs/Bitches (may be altered) shown with two to four of their offspring.

Class is judged on the merits of the offspring, but the parent will be examined for DQs/excuses.

Offspring must be entered in a regular conformation class.

Entry is made for the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch - offspring are not entered on the entry form.

#### Brace Class

For two dogs, regardless of sex, performing in unison and presented by one or two handlers.

Both dogs in each Brace must have at least one common owner.

Entrants need not be entered in any other class.

**AWARD OF MERIT:** These awards will be presented to the dogs or bitches, which, in the opinion of the judge, deserve special recognition and were not winners of BOB, BOS, or BOW. The number of Award of Merit prizes will be based on the number of dogs/bitches showing in the Best of Breed Competition; i.e. 10-19 dogs allow for up to 1 AOM award, 20-29 dogs allow for up to 2 AOM awards, etc.

**BEST VETERAN:** Winners of all the Veteran classes compete for this Special Award.

**BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR:** Winners of the Bred-By-Exhibitor classes compete for this Special Award.

The Conformation Judge will give a verbal critique of the dogs placing in each class as ribbons are awarded.

## JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

Novice class: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have not won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship class at a licensed or member show. The Novice class is divided:

- Novice Junior - 9 years and under 12 years on the day of the show;
- Novice Intermediate - 12 years and under 15 years on the day of the show;
- Novice Senior - 15 years and under 18 years on the day of the show.

Open class: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship class at a licensed or member show. The Open class is divided:

- Open Junior - 9 years and under 12 years on the day of the show;
- Open Intermediate - 12 years and under 15 years on the day of the show;
- Open Senior - 15 years and under 18 years on the day of the show.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Juniors must include their AKC Junior Handler number on the entry blank. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.

Dogs shown in Junior Showmanship may have Full or Limited AKC registration or have an ILP/PAL number. Altered animals are eligible to be shown, but bitches in season are not eligible.

## SWEEPSTAKES

All Great Pyreesees shown in either Sweepstakes MUST be entered in one of the Regular or Non-regular conformation classes. Indicate the Sweepstakes Class, with the age division, on the entry form in the "Additional Classes" box. Sweepstakes entries may be shown by anyone in good standing with the AKC.

### DISTRIBUTION OF SWEEPSTAKES PRIZE MONEY

15% of fees will be retained by Club for expenses. The remaining 85% (for each Sweepstakes, Puppy & Veteran) will be awarded to:

Best in Sweepstakes	12% of total Sweepstakes entry
Best Opp Sex (Puppy)/Reserve Best (Veteran)	6% of total Sweepstakes entry

Balance will be divided among the winners in each class as follows (percentages are based on the total entry fees for each class): First Prize-30% • Second Prize- 20% • Third Prize- 10% • Fourth Prize- 5%.

### Puppy Sweepstakes

Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all Great Pyreesees who are at least 6 months of age on the day of the sweepstakes, and may be entered only in the first National Puppy Sweepstakes for which it is eligible. Champions of Record may compete.

Litters must be nominated before birth. Puppies are eligible only for the first GPCA National Specialty Show held on or after the date they reach 6 months of age. They MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes at this show. Individual puppies must be nominated before 4 months of age, or they may be nominated with an additional \$5.00 per month, up to 6 months of age. Indicate the Futurity class, with age division, on the entry form in the "Additional Classes" box.

### DRAFT TEST CLASSES

Novice Draft: The Novice class shall be for dogs who have not earned the Draft Dog title (DD) or have earned the Draft Dog title (DD) but have not earned the Draft Dog Excellent title (DDX). All exercises except the recall, group stay, harnessing and hitching are performed on leash. However, the leash must be visibly slack and is not to be used to physically guide the dog during exercises. Guiding, jerking, and/or tight leash will result in a failing performance.

Open Draft: The Open Draft class shall be for dogs who have earned either the Draft Dog title (DD) or the Draft Dog Excellent title (DDX). All exercises except the Distance Freight Haul are performed off leash. Dogs shall be kept on leash when in the ring to receive awards.

Brace Novice Draft: Brace Novice Draft shall be for two-dog teams that have individually earned either their Novice Draft Dog (DD) or Draft Dog Excellent (DDX) title and have not earned a Brace Novice Draft title. All exercises are the same as those of Novice Draft.

AWARDS AND PRIZES: GPCA will award the Sheila Duff Memorial Medallion in the ring, and certificates at the 2010 National Specialty Show Banquet, to those who qualify. For those unable to attend the banquet, certificates will be mailed. GPCA Draft Committee will award a leash rack to all participants.

**LIABILITY:** It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Exhibitors should follow their Veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment.

**RINGSIDE:** Dogs may arrive at any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Judges will not wait for any dog. Owners and agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs at ringside when their class is called. The club, judges, stewards and secretary have no obligation or responsibility to announce for or locate dogs that are not at ringside when required.

### CONFORMATION CLASS ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

**Bred by Exhibitor entries** are for dogs 6 months of age or older who are not Champions of record on the date of closing for this show. The dog must be owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record, and must be shown in the BBE class by a breeder of record and an owner of record of the dog. If the dog wins the BBE class, there are no restrictions as to who may handle in any subsequent classes.

**Amateur Owner Handler entries** must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. The owner cannot have been, in any point in time, an AKC approved conformation judge, a professional handler, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. A professional handler is defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay.

**Judges & entries:** No entry shall be made at any show under a judge of any dog which said judge or any members of his immediate household or immediate family has been known to have owned, handled in the ring more than twice, sold, held under lease or boarded within one year prior to the date of the show. The above shall apply to judges of sweepstakes or futurities held with licensed or member shows exactly as it does to judges of regular competition at shows.

Judges shall avoid improprieties or perceived improprieties. Obviously some ethical rules are clear. For example: advise potential exhibitors not to enter under you when their presence or the presence of their dogs might give the impression of unfair advantage. For example, if the exhibitor is a person with whom you co-own dogs. The key is to avoid situations that might give the impression of impropriety.

**Puppy class entries:** Dogs must be entered in the age class calculated by using the first day of regular judging at the show (4/29/10). See the date ranges listed in the Conformation Class list in this premium.
